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Ensures children receive meals during the summer with free nutritious meals at approved sites. Free nutritious meals to children 18 and under in areas with high concentrations of low income children.

50% or more qualify for after school meals.

Reimbursed at highest rate possible.

Child and Adult care Food Program: Healthier Meals Initiative includes adult day care.

Improving nutrition in CACFP program for children - targeting children over age of 1.
