- Currently working on AIM program. On second meeting with schools. Starting to go to local businesses and do blood pressure checks and hypertension training.
- Hope to do health links training in July and worksite wellness.

Margaret Wacker, West Central Public Health Partnership

- Working on Health Links on the Western Slope.

Theresa Mickiewicz, Denver Public Health

- On the Metro Health Beverage Partnership.
- Also doing work with the Stapleton Partnership with Worksite Wellness.

Christine Dolan, Garfield County Public Health

- Live Well Community
 - Mini grant program through Live Well which enables funding of smaller things like community gardens, bike racks, etc.
 - Workgroups with Live Well. Currently working in Healthy Food and Beverage Work Group with some money from CCPD, looking at more policy level work. Also, doing assessments around vending.
 - Worksite wellness piece is within Garfield County and reaching out to the community.
 - Built Environment is working on a shared map for the community with walking trails and bike trails.
 - Brought in Cooking Matters this last year. Garfield is a satellite program and training trainers in the community. Currently have one group trained and they're holding classes.
- Have a vacancy for a Public Health Specialist to be posted soon on garfield-county.com.

Meredith Warman, Broomfield Public Health and Environment

- Gearing up for the food and beverage environment assessments of the city and county buildings, rec. center, and a school through the MHBP grant.
- Working on a mid-way revision of PHIP and seeing where able to leverage support for existing or upcoming efforts.

Pamela Gould, Jefferson County Public Health

- Hard at work with Jeffco Community Improvement Network. The Coalition on Healthy Beverages and a few other coalitions have gathered into a larger network. There have been a couple of network-wide meetings with community members. See healthypeoplehealthyplacesjeffco.com for more information.



- School Wellness Coalition - working on an assessment of water fountains in schools. Have promised funding on water jets in schools. Creating a more organized effort for Safe Rides to school.
- Healthy Beverage Coalition will start meeting this month.
- Food Policy Council, focusing on policies.
- Health and Early Childhood Collaborative is working to align HEAL work in the county and making sure everyone is communicating well.
- Mental Health Care is creating a resource care map.

3) Future Meeting Format and Topic Feedback

- Agree to imitate QI ECHO Model moving forward with the first 15 minutes dedicated to training webinar (state level effort) on a specific topic, followed by 15 minutes of case/presentation sharing (LPHA presents how have implemented similar work in their area), followed by a 30 minute discussion on that topic.

- Social marketing on how to promote cultural change through marketing
