Dear Liquor Industry Members, Local Clerks, and Stakeholders:

The Liquor Enforcement Division (LED) is commencing its yearly rule making process for rules to be effective January 1, 2020. The LED is convening a Liquor Rules Working Group (LRWG) to consider rules from the following categories:

1. Changes or additions to statutes;
2. Changes to regulations within the regulatory agenda (which are regulations 47-307 through 47-407, 1 C.C.R. 203-2);
3. Alcohol licensing on state-owned property;
4. 47-912 - Identification allowances;
5. Trade practices; and
6. Additions/changes from the LED and industry input.

The first meeting of the LRWG will be held on Monday, May 13, 2019 at 12:00 p.m. at:
