**1. Plant Annuals at Front Entrance - Petunias and sweet potato vines - 5-6 volunteers**

**Volunteers Bring - trowels, garden gloves, buckets of water and dippers, leaf rakes**

Provided - 6 bags of shredded red cedar mulch, plants, and small sod pins, extra emitters and

pigtails to adjust irrigation

**2. Repaint Taft Entrance Stucco Monument - 2-3 volunteers**

Leaders - Bobby Thomas, Lee Jennings, Bill Bristol

Provided - 3 gallons exterior latex paint to match existing, rollers, roller pans, brushes and small

containers, paper towels, bucket of water

**3. Refurbish Traffic Circle Landscaping - Revise drip irrigation in inner circle to stop overflow,**

remove unsightly ornamental grasses that have not been relocated by Keesen, freshen mulch

by raking - **2-3 volunteers**

Leaders - Bob Vaninger and Robert Faiks

**Volunteers Bring - knife, pliers, leaf rake, hoe, shovel**

Provided - Irrigation supplies

**4. Straighten Street and Traffic Signs, Relocate One Street Sign, Remove Landscape Stones**

**in Roadways - 1-2 volunteers**

Leaders - Phil Martinez and Bob Flynn, Greg Root

**Volunteers Bring - Broom, buckets for stone**

Provided - Wood shims, post hole digger, heavy hammer or sledge

**5. Install CFL Lights at Pool - 2-3 volunteers**

Provided - All supplies

**6. Wash Windows at Clubhouse Inside and Out - no ladders! - 2-3 volunteers**

**7. Paint/Re-paint Parking Stipes - 2-3 volunteers**

**8. Pick Up Trash in Foothills Park Especially from Edge of Water- Many volunteers**
