 Ex: enter birth hospital and date of birth
 Or: birth hospital and known first name

IDS Audiology Assessment Module Tips

- If PCP is unknown or there is no PCP, leave this field blank. The database will calculate a percentage of infants with a PCP listed, however if “unknown” is entered this will count as a PCP.
- Check address. If different, add new address. Database will automatically designate as primary address.
- When reporting on screenings, must check “override” box to open fields.
- When entering initial screen, must select a location by clicking on “Set Location”. If your location is not a hospital, select hospital of birth.
- If infant has a specific risk, add in the general box below list of risk factors.
- Must check type of visit. Can only select one.
- Amplification Date: this is the date that a fitting occurred or is scheduled to occur.
- CO-HEAR—this is a required field. If check “yes”, must enter CO-HEAR name and date of referral. CO-HEAR is determined by county of residence.
- Unilateral hearing loss should be referred to a CO-HEAR.
- When done entering data, MUST click UPDATE or will lose all data.
- System will time out at about 20 minutes of no use (if data is not saved, will lose data)
