DMV will begin scheduling new Colorado Road and Community Safety Act (SB13-251) appointments May 26 at three driver license offices

Reopening of Colorado Springs and Grand Junction offices on June 1

May 20, 2015 – DENVER, Colo. – Scheduling for new appointments for individuals seeking a driver license, instruction permit or identification card under the Colorado Road and Community Safety Act (CO-RCSA SB13-251) will begin on May 26, 2015. Appointments can be scheduled up to 90 days out and a quarter of the appointments will be released at each of these times 8 a.m., 12 p.m., 4 p.m. and 8 p.m.

Appointments will take place at the following driver license offices:

- Colorado Springs – 2447 N. Union Blvd., Colorado Springs
- Denver Central – 1865 W. Mississippi Ave., Suite C, Denver
- Grand Junction – 222 S. 6th St., #111, Grand Junction

Beginning June 1, 2015 a total of 93 customers will be served through appointments on a daily basis – 31 at each of the three offices listed above.

Appointments are required for individuals who are unable to demonstrate lawful presence in the U.S.

To schedule an appointment, go to www.colorado.gov/dmv or call 303-205-2335.

Individuals with confirmed existing appointments scheduled between June 1, 2015 and January 15, 2016 who wish to reschedule for another time or office may do so until May 22, 2015 by calling 303-205-2335. They will be required to provide their name, date of birth, appointment time and confirmation number. **Only individuals with previously confirmed CO-RCSA SB13-251 appointments should call the SB251 call center before May 26.**

Individuals who no longer need their appointment should call 303-205-2335 to cancel.

Individuals with confirmed existing appointments who do not wish to reschedule do not need to take any action. Their appointments will take place as currently scheduled.
