Turning the World Upside Down: The American Revolution

Registration open for new class

The Town of Estes Park's Senior Services Division and the Park School District Adult Outreach Program are offering a new class series called Turning the World Upside Down: The American Revolution. Professional educator Jeff Arnold will instruct the four-week series. The class will be held on Wednesdays, February 11, 18, 25 and March 4 from 4:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. in room 215 of the Estes Park Middle School, 1500 Manford Avenue. The cost for the class is \$30 for 2015 members of Estes Park Senior Citizens Center Inc. or \$40 for non-members. Register now at the Senior Center with cash or check payable to the Town of Estes Park. This class requires a minimum of ten students. The registration deadline is Wednesday, February 4. Please note that students do not need to have taken prior year classes in order to participate in the current session.

Instructor Jeff Arnold describes the class, "The American Revolution was more than just a war, but was an event that turned the world upside down. This course will focus on the causes of the war, the course of the fighting, the diplomatic maneuvers, and will ultimately try to answer the question, how did the colonists manage to defeat one of the greatest empires in the world? Along the way, many ideas that people have of the events will be challenged."

Jeff Arnold has been teaching United States history classes in Estes Park schools for over 20 years. He holds a BA in History from the University of Northern Colorado, an MA in Education from the University of Michigan and is a National Board Certified Teacher. His passion for history and extensive studies of American History bring excitement to these outstanding classes.
