Colorado DMV to open new Westminster Driver License Office on Wednesday, July 18

July 17, 2018 - Denver, Colo. - The Colorado Division of Motor Vehicles (DMV) is opening a new driver license office in Westminster on July 18, 2018, at 8430 Federal Blvd. The office will operate from 8 a.m. - 5 p.m. Monday through Friday.

The new location is conveniently located for the residents of Westminster and Arvada, the eighth and seventh largest cities in Colorado respectively. It will provide residents an additional option in a fast-growing area currently served by offices in Northglenn, Golden, Lakewood, Denver Northeast and Boulder.

The new driver license office is located right next to the existing Adams County motor vehicle office in Westminster that provides vehicle title and registration services, making this location a one-stop shop for both driver license and vehicle-related DMV services.

“This new location is part of the Division of Motor Vehicles’ continuing goal to improve customer service and reduce wait times by increasing access for Coloradans to DMV services,” said Driver License Director Brent Spahn. “This location will allow us to continue to serve our state’s growing population in an efficient manner.”

The following services will be offered at the new location:

- Issuance of new driver licenses, instruction permits and identification cards.
- Renewal of driver licenses, instruction permits and identification cards.
- Motor vehicle (driving) records.
- Knowledge tests for commercial driver licenses (CDL) and non-commercial driver licenses.
- Drive skills test for non-commercial driver licenses (appointment only).
