Below are the TDS levels for Box Elder Creek Ranch (BECR), Rocking Horse Farms (RHF) and Greatrock North (GN). I've been reporting on these numbers for the past several newsletters so that you can get a sense for how our water quality changes over time. This issue is addressed at each and every Board meeting and drives all of our efforts to live up to our mission statement as stated above.
