

Ordinance No. 121, 1962

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TERRITORY TO THE TOWN OF LA JARA

WHEREAS there has heretofore been presented to the Town Board of the Town of La Jara a written petition for the annexation of the following described property situate in the County of Conejos and State of Colorado, to-wit:

That certain tract of land described as follows: Commencing at a point on the East line of the Southwest Quarter of Section 14 in Township 35 North, Range 9 ENMPM which point is situated 55 feet North of the South quarter corner of said section; Thence running North along said East line 720 feet to a point; Thence Westerly to the Southeast corner of Block 36 in the Town of La Jara; Thence Westerly along said South line of said Block to the East edge of the right of way of the Richfield Canal; Thence Southwesterly along said right of way line 653 feet, more or less, to the point of intersection of said line with the East line of Braiden's Subdivision to the Town of La Jara; Thence Southerly 301 feet, more or less, along said East line of said Subdivision to a point which is 55 feet due North of the South line of said Section Fourteen; Thence East 1070 feet, more or less, parallel to said Section line and 55 feet distant therefrom to the point of beginning, containing 14 acres, more or less. Subject to rights of way for existing roads, ditches, telephone lines and power lines.

AND WHEREAS such petition was filed in form and manner as required by law and has been accepted by resolution of the Town Board and notice of filing thereof has been regularly given


NOW THEREFORE be it ordained by the Town Board of the Town of La Jara, Colorado:

SECTION 1: That the annexation proposed by said petition is approved in all respects and the property above described is hereby annexed to and made a part of the Town of La Jara, Colorado.
