

ORDINANCE No. 47

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TRAFFIC IN THE TOWN OF LA JARA.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF LA JARA, COLORADO;

Section 1. That SPRUCE Street from 1st Street to 4th Street, in the Town of La Jara, is hereby designated as a "through street". Signs bearing the word "STOP" shall be placed in the center or at the ~~right hand~~ side of all streets crossing such through street at or within thirty (30) feet of their intersection with such through street. The driver of any vehicle on any such cross street where such signs are in place shall come to a full stop before driving upon such through street, either for the purpose of turning into or of crossing the same.

Section 2. The Board of Trustees of the Town of La Jara at any time hereafter may designate any other street, or part of a street in the town of La Jara as a through street by resolution adopted at any meeting of said Board and when "STOP" signs shall be placed on streets crossing such through street or streets the drivers of vehicles upon such cross streets shall be governed by the same regulations as are set forth in Section 1 of this ordinance for drivers on streets crossing SPRUCE Street.

Section 3. That no person shall intentionally injure, deface, remove or destroy any "STOP" sign or other sign erected by authority of the Board of Trustees of the Town of La Jara on any streets or sidewalks of said Town for the purpose of regulating traffic.

Section 4. That any person who shall violate any provis-

ion of this ordinance shall on conviction thereof be fined not less than One Dollar (\$1.00) nor more than Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for each offense.
