Re: Nursing Facility PETI PAR Issue

Issue:

When creating a Nursing Facility (NF) PETI PAR, the member's information is not populating on the page as expected. Because of this, providers can not submit NF PETI PARs.

Work-around:

Providers can use the Member Focus View function to find the member, and can create a NF PETI PAR from there. Please follow [these instructions](#) for more detail.

Fix:

HPE is aware of the issue and is working on a fix. The fix is **currently scheduled** to go in on 4/14/17. **However, due to the complexity of the issue this date may change.**

Re: Claim Denials for EOB 1040

Why you're getting this error:

You submitted a Nursing Facility claim with an incorrect Type of Bill (TOB), which will cause an incorrect contract assignment and claims denials.

How to fix it:

Nursing Facility claims need to be submitted with the correct Nursing Facility TOB. **Intermediate Care Facility (ICF) codes and Nursing Facility codes are not interchangeable.** Please review the [Billing Manuals](#), and [NUBC Guidelines](#) for appropriate codes.

Example: Some NFs are submitting claims with ICF codes (65X or 66X), when they need to be submitting with NF codes (21X, 22X, etc.).
