Online renewal for diesel vehicles begins June 1, 2017

May 30, 2017 – DENVER, Colo. – The Colorado Division of Motor Vehicles, in conjunction with the Governor’s Office of Information Technology, the Statewide Internet Portal Authority (SIPA) and Colorado Interactive, have recently completed system upgrades that will allow diesel vehicles that require a passing emissions inspection, who have successfully passed that inspection, to renew their annual registration online beginning June 1, 2017. Diesel vehicles that do not require a passing emissions inspection may continue to renew online.

Online renewals may be completed at www.colorado.gov/renewplates.

Boulder, Jefferson, Broomfield, Denver and Douglas Counties, and portions of Adams, Arapahoe, Larimer, Weld and El Paso Counties require a passing diesel emission test to register a vehicle.

Colorado residents are encouraged to skip the trip to the DMV by using online vehicle registration renewal or one of the other 18 online services offered at mydmv.colorado.gov.
