

ORDINANCE NO. 113
Concerning Fire Bell

Be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the incorporated Town of Las Animas, Colorado.

Section 1

That any person or persons who shall ring or cause to be rung the fire bell on the Town hall in said except for the purpose of calling together the members of the hook and ladder and hose companies of said Town for the purpose of regular adjourned or special meeting; thereof or in any case where such person or persons shall be thereunto duly authorized by the Mayor or in his absence from the Town, the Mayor Pro-Tem of said Town in writing, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction thereof shall be fined in a sum not less than five dollars nor more than ten dollars.

Section 2

All ordinances and parts of ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 3

This ordinance shall take effect five days after its publication in the Bent County Democrat, the official paper of the Town of Las Animas.
