

## Ordinance No. 116

Concerning offenses affecting streets and public property.

Be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the incorporated town of Las Animas.

## Section 1.

If any person shall hitch or fasten any horse or any animal to any ornamental tree, fence or railing, or to any lamp post or railing upon any public ground or place, or upon any private premises he shall, upon conviction be fined not less than one dollar nor more than ten dollars for each offense.

## Section 2.

If any person who shall leave any horse or other animal attached to any carriage, wagon, cart, sleigh or other vehicle, in any street or alley within the town without securely fastening such horse or other animal, shall upon conviction, be fined not less than three dollars, nor more than ten dollars for each offense and shall further be liable for any damage occasioned by such horse or other animal.

## Section 3

Any person who shall engage in any sport or exercise likely to frighten horses injure passengers or embarrass the passage of persons or vehicles, shall upon conviction be fined not less than three dollars nor more than ten Dollars

for each offense.

Section 4

If any person shall aid or assist, or attempt to aid or assist, any person confined in the town Jail or lockup, to escape from such confinement, or shall without the consent of the person in charge of such place of confinement, introduce any spirituous or malt, liquors to any inmate, such person shall, upon conviction, be fined in any sum not less than five nor exceeding fifty dollars.

Section 5

Any person who shall place, or assist in placing or caused to be placed any rubbish or other obstruction of any kind or description in or upon the streets, alleys or right of way who shall neglect or refuse to remove the same for the space of twenty four hours after being notified so to do by the Marshal shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction, shall be fined not less than three dollars and not more than twenty dollars.

Section 6

No person shall cut, mark, burn, tear down, defair, or destroy any building, or portion of a building, any walk, fence, tree, plant or any other property not included in the foregoing enumeration, belonging to or used by the town or public places, or buildings, without lawful authority.

Section 7

It shall be unlawful for any person to in any manner meddle or interfere with mains, pipes, hose hydrants or any of the buildings machinery or any attachments of the town water works what ever, be the same used by private parties or by the town of Las Animas. Any person violating the provisions of this section shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction there of shall be fined in any sum not less than ten dollars nor more than twenty five dollars. This section shall not apply to any town officer or any person authorized to open and look after by drants.

Section 8

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistruet herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 9

This ordinance shall take effect five days after its publication in the Bent county Democrat, the official paper of the town of Las Animas.
