

Ordinance NO.129

Concerning the published volume of Ordinances

Be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the incorporated town of
Las Animas, State of Colorado.

Section 1.

Section 2

That all ordinances of the town of Las Animas heretofore passed in relation to the subject matter of or in consistent with any of the ordinances named in section(1) one of this ordinance are hereby readopted be and the same are hereby severally repealed; Provided that such repeal shall not effect any act done or right accrued or accruing or established nor any offense committed, nor any penalty or forfeiture incurred, nor any suit or prosecution pending at the time of such repeal for any offense committed on for any recovery of any forfeiture or penalty incurred under any ordinance so repealed.

Section 3

That all ordinances mentioned in section one of this ordinance, and including this ordinance contained in the book aforesaid entitled "The Ordinance of the Town of Las Animas, Colorado," as compiled and revised and passed the 6th day of April, A.D.1896, and published by authority of the Board of Trustees of the Town of Las Animas by the Bent County Democrat be and the same are hereby declared to be the ordinances of the Town of Las Animas, Colorado.

Section 4

All ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 5

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days from and after its publication in the Bent County Democrat, the official paper of the town of Las Animas, Colorado.

Rules and Order of Business of the Board of Trustees

The Board of Trustees shall hold its regular meetings weekly on Mondays at 7:30 PM at the town hall in Las Animas, Colorado.

The rules of procedure and order of business shall be strictly complied with unless suspended by a two-third vote of the members present.

A majority of the Board of Trustees elect shall constitute a Quorum to do business but a minority of the members of the Board elect may adjourn from day to day.

The Mayor shall preside at all meetings of the Board and in case of his absence or non-attendance the Mayor pro-tem shall preside and in the absence of both he shall be chosen from the quorum present.

At the hour appointed for meeting the members shall be called to order by the Mayor or in his absence the Mayor pro-tem in his absence the clerk shall proceed to call the roll and note the absentees and announce whether a quorum be present, if a quorum be present the Board shall proceed to business before then which shall be in the following;

1. Reading the minutes of the last meeting and approval of the same.
2. Presentation of petitions and report of officers which shall be in the following manner: treasurer, recorder, police judge, and Marshal.
3. Reports of standing committees which shall be as follows:
Committee of Finance: streets and Bridges; Public Works: Health, Assessments: Ordinance: Licenses:
4. Reports of special meetings.
5. Unfinished business.
6. Communications.
7. Miscellaneous business. All questions relating to priority of business shall be decided without debate.

The Mayor shall preserve order and decorum and shall decide all questions of order. Every member previous to speaking shall address the Mayor

(or Chairman) but shall not proceed until recognized by the Chair.

Motions shall have precedence in the following order: 1. To lay on the table; 2. To postpone; 3. To commit; 4. To amend.

A motion to adjourn shall be in order and shall have precedence over all others and shall be decided without debate.

Every member who shall be present when a question is stated from the chair shall vote thereon unless he be directly or indirectly interested in the question in which case he shall not vote. The Yeas and Nays may be called for by any member in which case the members voting shall be recorded on the minutes.

All committees shall be appointed by the chairman.

All reports of committees shall be made in writing and addressed to the Board of Trustees of Las Animas.

Motion of special meeting shall be served personally on each member of the Board by the Marshall or by leaving a copy of the notice at his usual place of business.

The Board shall keep a journal of its proceedings which shall at all times be open for inspection.

Standing committees shall be appointed annually, the person first named on the committee shall be chairman thereof and the following shall be the standing committees: Finance; Streets and Bridges; Public Works; Health; Assessments; Ordinances; Licenses.

No bill shall be approved unless the expenditure shall have been previously ordered by the Board of Trustees except for emergency which will not admit of delay.
