

ORDINANCE NO. 130.

APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE.

Entitled an appropriation ordinance for the fiscal year commencing on the first day of April, 1897, and ending on the 31st day of March, 1898.

Be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the incorporated town of Las Animas.

SECTION 1. That in accordance with the Statutes of the State of Colorado, there is hereby appropriated out of the funds belonging to the incorporated town of Las Animas, County of Bent and State of Colorado, the following amounts for the hereinafter stated funds for the fiscal year commencing April 1st, 1897, and ending March 31st, 1898:

Fire Department.....	\$ 200 00
Police and Marshal.....	750 00
Recorder, Librarian and Weigher,	600 00
Streets and Bridges.....	250 00
Printing and Stationery.....	250 00
Prisoners and jail.....	50 00
Interest on water works bonds...	2,240 00
Running expenses of Water works,	1,500 00
Current and general expenses.....	800 00
Public library.....	100 00

SECTION 2. There is also appropriated the sum of two hundred and fifty (250 00) dollars that has been awarded by the Commissioners of Bent County, for use on the public streets of Las Animas, said sum to be used exclusively in furnishing material for grading one or more blocks or streets, and be accounted for as a special appropriation bridges.

SECTION 3. This ordinance five days after its publication in the COUNTY DEMOCRAT, the official newspaper of the town of Las Animas.

NOTE. Passed at a regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Incorporated Town of Las Animas a majority of the members elected to said Board voting by the following vote: Kramer, George E. McCauley, Benjamin Neher, George D. H. Marshall. Nays, none.
