

ORDINANCE NO. 151
Concerning Licenses

Be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Incorporated Town of Las Animas. To amend an ordinance entitled "An ordinance No. 118 concerning licenses". Approved April 1st, 1896. Article 2 of said Ordinance No. 118, which commences after Section 14 Article 1.

Section 1

Any person or persons who shall own or conduct or manage for gain within the incorporated limits or within one mile thereof of the Town limits, a circus, caravan or other exhibition, show or amusement which shall be under a canvas or tent. Shall first pay a Town license of not less than ten dollars and not more than one hundred dollars.

Section 2

Bill Posters. Any person who shall distribute, tack or post any posters, circulars, dodgers or other bills or devices used to advertise theatres, shows, performances or any other purposes used to advertise or attract public attention shall first pay a license fee of fifteen dollars per year. Provided it shall not be necessary for any resident merchant or manufacturer, to obtain a license to advertise their business by distributing notices but not tack or post any bills or posters, and it shall not be necessary for any person or persons to obtain a license to advertise any charitable or religious purposes. and any person with or without a license shall not post any bills or dodgers or any advertising on or to any person's houses, homes, barns or any other stationary property, unless he shall first have obtained the owners consent.

Section 3

Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this Article No. 1 of this amended ordinance shall, upon conviction be fined not less than three dollars nor more than one hundred dollars.
