

Ordinance No 161

Entitled "An Ordinance to Amend Section #1 of Ordinance #112."

Be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Incorporated Town of Las Animas:

Section 1

No Horse, ass, mule, cattle, sheep, swine or goats, shall be permitted to run at large within the corporate limits of the Town of Las Animas, at any time during the day or night of any day during the year, and any of the above named stock running at large is hereby declared a nuisance, and such animal so found at large shall be taken up and impounded by the town Marshall.

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 2

This Ordinance to take effect after its legal publication in the Las Animas Leader, the Official Paper of the Town of Las Animas.
