

Ordinance 165

An Ordinance Concerning Bowling Alleys.

Be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Incorporated Town of Las Animas.

That it shall be unlawful for any person or persons to maintain or conduct any bowling alley or bowling alleys within the corporate limits of the Town of Las Animas to be patronized by the public unless such person or persons shall first procure from the Clerk of said Town of Las Animas a license so to do.

The license fee for maintaining or conducting each and every bowling alley within the corporate limits of the Town of Las Animas shall be the sum of Fifteen (\$15.00) Dollars per year, payable quarterly in advance, for each and every bowling alley so maintained and conducted.

Any person or persons who shall violate any of the provisions of this Ordinance or who shall maintain or conduct any bowling alley or bowling alleys within the corporate limits of the Town of Las Animas to be patronized by the public without a license so to do unexpired and unrevoked, shall for each and every such offense, upon conviction or fined in the sum of not less than Five (\$5.00) Dollars, or more than Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars.

This Ordinance, shall take effect after its final adoption by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Las Animas, County of Bent and State of Colorado.

NOTE: Passed at a regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of the incorporated Town of Las Animas, January 2, 1906 a majority of the whole number of members elected to said Board Concurring by the following vote: Viz; Ayes: Johnston; Powell, North and Hardy. Nays: none.
