

Ordinance No 169.

An Ordinance concerning, Pool Rooms, Billiard Rooms, and shooting Galleries.

Be it Ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Incorporated town of Las Animas.

Section 1

That it shall be unlawful for any person to keep or maintain, any room or place, within the corporate limits of the incorporated town of Las Animas, wherein pool games and Billiard games, or shooting galling shall be conducted for hire, unless such person shall first obtain from the Clerk and Recorder of said incorporated town of Las Animas, a license, so to do.

Section 2

The License fee for keeping or maintaineng any room or place, where said games of Podl, Billiards or shooting gallery shall be conducted for hire, shall be Five (\$5.00) Dollars per half year, for each pool table or Billiard table kept or maintained therein, and (\$5.00) Five Dollard for each shooting gallery kept or maintained.

Section 3

Nothing in this ordinance shall be construed to affect any regularly licensed saloon within the corporate limits of said town of Las Animas, not maintaining more than one pool table and one Billiard table, to two of either pool or billiard tables.

Section 4

Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction shall be fined not less than five (\$5.00) Dollars nor more than Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars.

This Ordinance shall take affect five days after its publication in the Bent County Democrat, the official paper of the Town of Las Animas, Colorado.
