

ORDINANCE No. 178

An ordinance calling a special Election providing for the submission to the vote of the qualified Electors of the Town of Las Animas, at said Election, question of authorizing the Board of Trustees of the Said Town to make extensions of and additions to the water system of the Town of Las Animas, to be owned, managed and operated by the said Town.

Be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Incorporated Town of Las Animas, Colorado.

Section 1

That a special Election of the values of the Town of Las Animas, Colorado, who are tax payers under the law, be called, and said Election is hereby called for Tuesday the 16th day of July, A.D. 1907.

Section 2

That at said Election the question of authorizing the Board of Trustees of said Town to erect and construct extensions of and additions to the system of water works for fire and domestic purposes, now owned and operated by said Town, said extensions and additions to be owned, managed and operated by said Town, and the same is hereby submitted to such voters of said Town as are tax payers under the law, for their determination.

Section 3

The question as submitted shall be voted on at said Election by the voters qualified as aforesaid at the following place in the said Town of Las Animas, in the County of Bent and State of Colorado, to-wit: at the Town Hall in said Town.

The voting shall be by ballot of the form hereinafter provided, and said Election shall be in all respects, as nearly as may be, held and conducted in the manner prescribed by law in cases of Elections for Municipal Officers.

Section 4

The ballots to be used in voting upon the question above submitted shall be prepared and furnished by the Town Clerk to the Judges of Election to be by them furnished to the voters, and shall be in the following form:

"For the erection and construction of Extensions of and additions to the system of Water Works for fire and domestic purposes, now owned and operated by the Town of Las Animas, Colorado, and extensions to be owned, managed, and operated by the said Town".

"Against the erection and construction of extensions of and additions to the system of Water Works for fire and domestic purposes, now owned and operated by the Town of Las Animas, Colorado, said extensions to be owned, managed and operated by the said Town."

Said ballots shall be cast by each voter by making an "X" opposite his choice in the manner now provided by law for voting upon amendments to the Constitution of the State of Colorado.

Section 5

No ballot for or against said question shall be received by the Judges unless the person offering the same shall be a voter of the Town of Las Animas, Colorado, and a tax payer under the law.

Section 6

The following persons are hereby appointed as Judges and Clerks of said Election to-wit: H.W.Vigar, J.M.Marshall and Ben Neher for Judges and P.J.Fredrick and C.E.Sydner for Clerks.

Section 7

The votes on said Election on the question aforesaid shall be canvassed and the returns made and the result declared in the same manner, as nearly as may be, as provided by law for the canvass, return and declaring of the result of votes cast at Election of Municipal Officers.

Section 8

The notice of the time and place of said election shall be published in the Bent County Democrat, a newspaper of general circulation, printed in the Town of Las Animas, in the County of Bent and State of Colorado, at least fifteen days before such election, announcing the time, place and object of the election, and the Town Clerk of the Town of Las Animas, Colorado, is hereby charged with the duty of effectuating this ordinance.

Section 9

This Ordinance after its passage shall be recorded in a book kept for that purpose be authenticated by the signature of the Mayor and Clerk and shall be published in the Bent County Democrat a newspaper published within the Limits of the Town of Las Animas, Colorado, and shall take effect and be in the force published.
