

Ordinance No 183

An Ordinance permitting the use of part of Vigil Avenue and Fourteenth street for railway Track purposes.

Be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Incorporated Town of Las Animas, Colorado:

Section 1

There is hereby granted to E.J. Culing, his heirs, assigns, the right to construct and to perpetually operate and maintain a single track, standard gauge of railway for the purpose of running, loading and unloading cars from a point fifty feet east of the east line of Bent Avenue on Fourteenth street, and extending thence in an easterly direction on and over Fourteenth street and Vigil Avenue to a connection with the track or tracks of the Atchinson, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway.

Section 2

Said Track shall be located upon such grade as the Board of Trustees of the town of Las Animas, Colorado, shall direct, and shall be provided with such protection as shall be necessary to prevent cars running West of said fifty foot; point mentioned in section, one of this Ordinance and said track shall be provided with necessary crossings on Vigil Avenue and on Fourteenth Street and alley crossings where said track shall intersect the north and South alley in Block No 120, and said track shall extend on and over said Fourteenth Street and Vigil Avenue in an easterly direction for a distance of not over one hundred and forty feet east of the East line of said Vigil Avenue as to conveniently connect with the Track or tracks of the Atchinson, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company, The heirs and assigns, shall at all times keep that portion of said track lying between the east line and the West line of Vigil Avenue free from standing cars, and shall at no time block said street with cars or Engines for a greater period of time than ten minutes without cutting such cars or engines for the passage of vehicles.

Section 3

Said E.J. Culing his heirs and assigns, shall hold said Town of Las Animas, free and harmless from all damages or claims by all persons whomsoever, arising by reason of the construction of or the negligent maintenance of or negligent use of said road or track so to be constructed, The Board of Trustees of the Town of Las Animas reserves the right to make such reasonable ordinances and resolutions concerning the use and operation of said track as shall be reasonable and necessary for the government of said Town and the Protection of the inhabitants thereof.

Section 4

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and after five days from the publication thereof in the Bent County Democrat.
