

An Ordinance guaranteeing on behalf of the Town of Las Animas, Colorado, the payment of all Local improvement bonds of sidewalk and grading District No 2. of the Town of Las Animas, Colorado.

Be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Las Animas, Colorado.
Section 1.

That pursuant to the Authority visited in the Board of Trustees of the Town of Las Animas, Colorado, by section 40 of an Act entitled an Act to provide for the construction of Local improvement in Cities of all classes having a population of less than one hundred thousand and incorporated towns. The issuance of Local improvement bonds therefor and the assessment and payment of the cost of said improvements, Approved April 8th, 1899; The Town of Las Animas, does hereby guarantee the payment of all local improvement bonds of sidewalk and Grading District No 2, of the Town of Las Animas, Colorado which said local improvement bonds are particularly described as follows, in a resolution adopted by the Board of Trustees of said Town, on the 1st. day of July, 1907, to-wit: Forty-one bonds of the denomination of Two Hundred and Fifty (\$250.00) dollars each, and ~~Twenty bonds of the denomination of Five Hundred (\$500.00) each.~~ all of which bonds are dated July 1st. 1907 and payable June 30th, 1927, if not sooner called and paid.

Section 2

That the Mayor and Town Clerk at the Town of Las Animas, Colorado, be and they are hereby authorized to endorse on each of the aforesaid local improvement bonds, the following guaranty: Payment of the within bond is guaranteed, by the Town of Las Animas, Colorado, by ordinance No. 188, of said Town entitled, "An Ordinance Guaranteeing on behalf of the town of Las Animas, Colorado, the payment of all local improvement bonds of Sidewalks and Grading District No 2, of the Town of Las Animas, Colorado. "Which said ordinance was adopted on the 6th day of April A.D. 1908, by a two thirds vote of the Board of Trustees of said Town.
