Ordinance No. 195

An Ordinance guaranteeing on Behalf of the Town of Las Animas, Colorado the Payment of all local improvement Bonds of sidewalk and grading District No Four of the Town of Las Animas, Colorado.

Be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Las Animas, Colo., Section 1.

That pursuant to the authority vested in the Board of Trustees of the Town of Las Animas, Colorado, by section 40 of an act entitled, " An Act to provide for the construction of Local improvements in cities of all classes having a population of less than one hundred thousand, and incorporated towns, the issuance of local improvement bonds there for, and the assessment a and payment of the cost of said improvements, " Approved April 8, 1899, in force April 8, 1899, L. '99 P 393, Ch. 151. The Town of Las Animas does hereby guarantee the payment of all local improvement bonds of Sidewalk and grading District No. Four of the Town of Las Animas, Colorado, which said local improvement bonds are particularly described as follows in an Ordinance passed and by the Board of Trustees of Said Town, on the 20th day of July, A.D 1908. to-wit: seventeen bonds of the denomination of two hundred and fifty dollars each, and thirty bonds of the denomination of five hundred dollars each all of which bonds are dated July 1st. 1908, and payable July 1st. 1928 if not sooner called and paid.

Section 2

That the Mayor and Town Clerk of the Town of Las Animas, Colorado, be, and they are hereby authorized to endorse on each of the aforesaid local improvement bonds the following guaranty; Payment of the within Bond is guaranteed by the Town of Las Animas, Colorado, by Ordinance No. 195 of said Town, entitled "An Ordinance Guaranteeing, on behalf of the Town of Las Animas, Colorado the payment of all local improvement bonds of Sidewalk and Grading District No. Four of the Town of Las Animas," Which said Ordinance was adopted on the 21st. day of September, 1908, by a two third vote of the Board of Trustees of said town.

The said guaranty on said bonds may be authenticated by the engraved, printed, written or lithographed signatures of the Mayor and the Town Clerk of Said Town.

Section 3

This Ordinance shall be published in the Bent County Democrat and shall be in full force and effect in five days from and after such publication and shall be inepalable until the indebtedness herein guaranteed shall have been fully paid.
