

Ordinance No. 198.

An Ordinance prohibiting the keeping of chairs and tables within all saloons at and within the corporate limits of the town of Las Animas.

Be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the town of Las Animas, Colorado:

Section 1. That it shall be unlawful for any keeper, manager or any other person maintaining any saloon within the corporate limits of the town of Las Animas, Colorado, to keep and maintain within any such saloon, chairs and tables, or either such, to be used by the public.

Section 2. Any person who shall violate any provision of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof forfeit a sum not less than five (\$5) dollars nor more than fifty (\$50) dollars.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after five days from the date of its publication in the Bent County Democrat.
