

ORDINANCE NO. 204.

Be it Ordained by the City Council of the City of Las Animas, Colorado:


Section 1. That all public streets and alleys lying and being within the following metes and bounds in the City of Las Animas, Colorado, be and the same are hereby vacated and abandoned, to-wit: Beginning at the North West corner of Lot 13 in Block 153, in the City of Las Animas; thence East a distance of approximately 954 feet to an intersection with the East corporate limit of the City of Las Animas, being the East line of Section 10, Township 23 South of Range 52 West; thence South along said Corporate limit to the South East corner of the North East Quarter of the South East Quarter of said Section 10, being the South East corner of said City of Las Animas; thence West along the South line of said North East Quarter of the South East Quarter of Section 10, being also the South Corporate limit of the said City of Las Animas, a distance of approximately 954 feet to an intersection with the West line of Lot No. 31 in Block 176 in the City of Las Animas; thence North a distance of approximately 725 feet to the North West corner of lot No. 13 in Block 153, in the City of Las Animas, same being the point of beginning.
