

ORDINANCE NO. 215.

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING PLACES OF AMUSEMENT.

Be it Ordained by the City Council of the City of Las Animas, Colorado.

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, or persons, to maintain any moving picture exhibition, where an admission fee is charged, for entrance thereto, within the corporate limits of the City of Las Animas, Colorado, without a license so to do first had and obtained from the said City of Las Animas, Colorado.

Section 2. Any person desiring to obtain a license for the purpose of conducting a moving picture exhibition within the corporate limits of the City of Las Animas, Colorado shall apply to the City Clerk of said City therefor, and pay to said City Clerk for the use of the said City of Las Animas, Colorado, the sum of Twenty five (\$25.00), stating in such application the premises where said exhibition is to be maintained and the name, or names, of the persons desiring such license, whereupon the City Council of said city of Las Animas may grant the same; and all licenses granted hereunder shall expire on the 31st day of December of each year after the same has been granted.


Section 3, .Any person or persons, who shall violate any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction, be fined in the sum of not less than Five Dollars (\$5.00) nor more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00).
