

An Ordinance levying a Tax upon property in the City of Las Animas, Bent County, Colorado.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Las Animas, Colorado:

Section One. That for the purpose of paying interest on the outstanding water works bonds of the City of Las Animas, which interest will be due and payable in the year 1913, there shall be levied and collected a tax upon all the property in the City of Las Animas, Colorado, of 23 mills upon each dollar of the assessed valuation thereof.

Section Two. That for paying the running expenses and for general corporate purposes of said of Las Animas for the year of 1913 there shall be levied and collected a tax upon all the property in the City of Las Animas of 10 mills upon each dollar of the assessed valuation thereof.

Passed adopted at a regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Las Animas, Colorado this 28th day of October 1912.
