Las Animas, Colorado, shall Pay to the City Clerk of Las Animas, for use of said city, the sum of not less than \$10.00 per day and not more than \$300.00 per day for each and every day such carnival, circus, exhibition or amusement shall be maintained, conducted or operated within said city of Las Animas, as shall be determined by the Mayor and City Council of said City of Las Animas, Colorado.

SECTION FOUR: Any person who shall violate any provision of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and shall, upon conviction therefor, be fined in the sum of not less than \$10.00 and not more than \$300.00 for each and every offence and shall, upon failure to pay such fine, be committed to the City Jail of the City of Las Animas, for a term not to exceed Ninety (90) days or until such fine shall be paid.

SECTION FIVE: All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances, in conflict herewith, are hereby repealed.
