

ORDNANCE NO. 240.

Entitled and Ordinance of the City of Las Animas, Colorado, for the Regulation of drays and other vehicles used within the corporate limits of said City for hauling for hire, and repealing Ordinance Number 131 passed and adopted by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Las Animas, July 2, 1897, and Ordinance Number 163 Passed and adopted by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Las Animas, April 3, 1905.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Las Animas, Colorado:

SECTION ONE: It shall be unlawful for any person or persons, company or corporation to do any manner of hauling for hire as a drayman, expressman or deliveryman, of any box, package, load or property of any kind whatsoever, without first having obtained a license as hereinafter provided by this Ordinance.

SECTION TWO: The City Clerk of the City of Las Animas, Colorado, may issue a license to any applicant therefor for the purposes named in the foregoing section upon payment as follows:

For each vehicle drawn by horses, \$3.00.

For each motor vehicle, \$5.00.

SECTION THREE: Each and all licenses issued hereunder shall expire on the 31st day of December of each and every calendar year.

SECTION FOUR: Ordinance Number 131, passed and adopted by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Las Animas, Colorado, and Ordinance 163 passed and adopted by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Las Animas April 3, 1905, be and same are hereby repealed.

SECTION FIVE: Any person who shall violate any provision of the foregoing Ordinance shall be upon conviction deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and fined in a sum of not less than Five Dollars nor more than Twenty-Five Dollars.

Passed and adopted at a regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Las Animas, Colorado, the 1st day of October A.D. 1917.
