

ORDINANCE NO. 247.

An Ordinance Limiting the Speed of Automobiles, Motorcycles and other Vehicles within the Corporate Limits of the City of Las Animas, Colorado.

Be it Ordained by th City Council of the City of Las Animas, Colorado;

SECTION ONE. That Section One of the Ordinance No.208 of the City of Las Animas, Colorado, adopted the 20th day of October 1909, be amended to read as follows:

It shall be unlawful for any person to ride or drive any automobile, motorcycle, or or other vehicle on any street or alley or highway within the corporate limits of the City of Las Animas, Colorado, at a greater speed than 15 miles per hour.

SECTION TWO. And that all other Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict are herewith amended.
