

ORDINANCE NO. 248.

An Ordinance Concerning the Laying of Lead Water Lines in the Streets of the City of Las Animas.

Be it Ordained by the City Council of the City of Las Animas, Colorado:

SECTION ONE. That when any water line in the street from the main, is being repaired in any part, that the entire water line from the main to the curb not a lead line shall be replaced by a lead line. The owner of the water line to pay for the replacement.

SECTION TWO. That all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
