

ORDINANCE NO 259.

Passed by the City Council and
approved by the Mayor of the City of
Las Animas, Colorado, the 24th day of
March, A. D. 1927.

It was moved by Alderman Cheek and seconded by Alderman Faucett that the following Proposed Ordinance be passed. Upon roll call the following vote was had:

Aye: Alderman Chas. M. Cheek, George W. Powell, Henry Hayhurst, B. H. Faucett, H. E. Gilliland and H. D. Kennedy.

Nay: None.

An Ordinance concerning the attachment of telegraph, radio, wireless telephone or wireless telegraph, apparatus or any other metal, wood or other substance to telegraph, telephone, electric light, electric railway, or power wires, poles or cross arms also concerning running radio wires over power wires when crossing streets or alleys.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS ANIMAS, COLORADO.

Section 1. That it shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to attach, fix, place, install or maintain or permit or suffer to be attached, affixed, placed, installed or maintained any telegraph, radio, wireless telephone, or wireless telegraph apparatus or any other metal, wood or other substance to, on or upon any telephone, telegraph, electric light, electric railway or power wires, poles or attachments belonging to another person, firm or corporation, without

the consent of such person, firm or corporation given in writing.

Section two. That it shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation when running any radio wire across any street or alley of said city to run same over or above any power wire of said street or alley.

Section Three. From and after the passage of this ordinance any person, firm or corporation that shall violate any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction, be fined not less than ten dollars nor more than one hundred dollars and each day's violation thereof shall constitute a separate offense.
