

ORDINANCE NO. 266

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE DENOMINATION OF THE BONDS TO BE ISSUED BY THE CITY OF LAS ANIMAS FOR PAVING DISTRICT NO. 1; AND PROVIDING FOR THE GUARANTY OF SAID BONDS BY SAID CITY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS ANIMAS:

Section 1. That the bonds of paving District No. 1, Las Animas, Colorado, authorized by Ordinance No. 265, adopted and approved on the 10th day of September, A. D. 1928, shall be in the denomination of \$500.00.

Section 2. That pursuant to the authority vested in the City Council of the City of Las Animas by section 33 of "An act relating to local improvements in cities and towns", approved April 9, 1923, the City of Las Animas, Colorado, does hereby guarantee the payment of all the said local improvement bonds of Paving District No. 1, Las Animas, Colorado, which bonds are particularly described in and authorized by said Ordinance No. 265, and that the Mayor and City Clerk of the City of Las Animas be, and they are hereby authorized and directed to endorse on each of the aforesaid local improvement bonds the following guaranty:

"Payment of the within bond is guaranteed by the City of Las Animas, Colorado, by Ordinance numbered 266, of said city, which ordinance was adopted, duly approved and made a law of said city on the 12th day of January, A. D. 1929, by a two-thirds vote of all the members of the City Council of the City of Las Animas, Colorado.

Section 3. By reason of the fact that paving improvements in said district are about to be completed and the fact that the contractor constructing said improvements is entitled under his contract to be paid for said construction work from the proceeds of the bonds heretofore authorized, it is hereby declared that an emergency exists and that the enactment of this ordinance is necessary to the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and shall be in force and take effect five days after its final publication.
