

**ORDINANCE NO. 315**

An ordinance providing for the coverage of specified officers and employees of the City of Las Animas, Colorado, in the federal old-age and survivor's insurance system under the terms of Section 218 of Public Law 734, 81st Congress, and House Bill 291, Session Laws of Colorado, 1951.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Las Animas, Colorado:

Section 1. That the City of Las Animas do provide old-age and survivor's insurance coverage for its officers and employees hereinafter specified in the Federal Old-age and Survivor's Insurance system under the terms of Section 218 of Public Law 734, 81st Congress, and House Bill 291, Session Laws of Colorado, 1951.

Section 2. The mayor and clerk of the City of Las Animas, Colorado, are hereby authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with the Department of Employment Security, State of Colorado, on behalf of the City of Las Animas, Colorado, to do all things necessary to provide for the partici-

patron by the City of Las Animas in the Federal Old-age and Survivor's Insurance System and to effectuate coverage of the officers and employees hereinafter specified from and after December 31, 1951.

Section 3. The Clerk and Treasurer of the City of Las Animas are hereby authorized and directed to establish a system of payroll deduction to be matched by payments by the City of Las Animas as required by the "Federal Insurance Contributions Act" (Section 1400 et seq. Federal Internal Revenue Code) upon all services herein authorized to be covered and to pay the amounts so derived to the Department of Employment Security, State of Colorado, on or before the 18th day of the month immediately following the completed calendar quarter.

Section 4. Services of all officers and employees, whether engaged in "proprietary" or "governmental" functions shall be covered except:

- (1) Any service performed by an employee in a position covered by a retirement system on the date this agreement is made applicable to his coverage group.
- (2) Service performed by an em-

ployee who is employed to relieve him from unemployment.

(3) Service performed in a hospital, home or other institution by an inmate thereof.

(4) Covered transportation service (as defined in Section 210 (1) of the Social Security Act.)

(5) Service (other than agricultural labor or service performed by a student) excluded from employment by any provisions of section 210 (a) of the Social Security Act, other than paragraph (8) of such section.

(6) Services of an emergency nature, such as those required to care for fires, floods or other unforeseen disasters.

(7) Services of an extremely temporary nature such as posseman, election judges, etc., or those compensated solely on a fee basis.
