Alderman Nelson introduced an ordinance entitled: # 324

Parking

"AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE TIME AND MANNER
OF PARKING MOTOR VEHICLES ON CERTAIN STREETS
OF LAS ANIMAS"

ORDINANCE

Section 1. That from and after the effective date of this ordinance it shall be unlawfull between the hours of 8:00 A. M. and 8:00 P. M. excepting Sundays and legal holidays to park any motor vehicle in one place for longer than two hours on the following designated streets and areas, to-wit:

(a) Bent Avenue from its intersection with Fourth Street, south to its intersection with the alley south of the intersection of Bent Avenue and Sixth Street.

(b) Sixth Street from a point 180 feet east of its intersection with Bent Avenue and on the south side of the street west to a point 150 feet west of the intersection of carson avenue and Sixth Street, and on the north side of the street to point 120 feet west of the intersection of Carson Avenue and Sixth Street.

(c) Carson Avenue from the point of its intersection with Fifth Street, south to the point where it intersects with the first alley south of the intersection of Carson Avenue with Sixth Street.

(d) Fifth Street from the point where it intersects with Carson Avenue east to a point 180 feet east of the intersection of Fifth Street with Sixth Street and Bent Avenue.

Section 2. Every person violating this ordinance upon conviction, shall be subject to a fine of not less than \$1.00 nor more than \$25.00.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances, heretofore enacted, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 4. That by reason of the present congested traffic conditions in the business district and on State Highway connecting links and the approaching seasonal heavy movement of traffic an emergency exists and this ordinance is hereby found, determined, and declared to be necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety and shall be in full force and effect from and after the fifth day after the date of its last publication.
