ALLEYS

ORDINANCE NO. 332

AN ORDINANCE VACATING PORTIONS OF THE ORIGINAL ALLEYS IN BLOCKS 29 AND 30, CITY OF LAS ANIMAS, AND APPROVING, RATIFYING AND CONFIRMING THE DEDICATION OF NEW ALLEYS AND THE RE-LOCATION AND RE-NUMBERING OF THE LOTS IN SAID BLOCKS AS ESTABLISHED AND DESCRIBED IN THE PLAT OF WADE'S SUBDIVISION OF SAID BLOCKS 29 AND 30 AND ADOPTING SAID PLAT AS THE OFFICIAL PLAT OF SAID BLOCKS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS ANIMAS, COLORADO:

Section 1. There is hereby vacated that portion of the top bar of the "T" alley in Block 29 as originally established twenty feet by one hundred forty feet, which extends East from an extension of the east side of the north and south leg of said "T" alley to the east side of said block, and that portion of the top bar of the "T" alley in Block 29 as originally established twenty feet by one hundred forty feet which extends west from an extension of the west side of the north and south leg of said "T" alley to the west side of said block, also described as the south twenty feet of Lots 6 and 22 of Block 29 of Wade's Subdivision of said Block

reserving nevertheless unto the City easements for existing sewer, gas, telephone and electric transmission lines.

Section 2. There is hereby vacated that portion of the top bar of the alley in Block 30 as originally established twenty feet by one hundred forty feet which extends east from an extension of the east side of the north and south leg of said "T" alley to the east side of said block and that portion of the top bar of the "T" alley in Block 30 as originally established twenty feet by one hundred forty feet, which extends west from an extension of the west side of the north and south leg of said "T" alley to the west side of said block also described as the south twenty feet of Lots 6 and 22 of Block 30 of Wade's Subdivision of said Block, reserving nevertheless, unto city easements for existing sewer, gas, telephone and electric transmission lines.

Section 3. The City Council does hereby approve, ratify and confirm the plat of Block 29 and 30 as established by the plat of Wade's Subdivision of said blocks. Specifically, the establishment of alleys twenty feet in width including the leg or standard of the original "T" alley and extending in a straight line to the north boundary of said blocks, the dedication of the east ten feet of Lot 6 and the west ten feet of Lot 7 in each block to public use as an alley, and the designation and numbering of lots fronting west in the case of each block, numbering from north to south, as one to sixteen and of lots fronting east in the case of each block, numbering from north to south, as seventeen to thirty-two, all as established in the plat of Wade's Subdivision of said blocks, which plat is hereby approved, ratified and confirmed and adopted as the official plat of said blocks.

Introduced, read and adopted on first reading, and ordered published, this 6th day of September, A. D. 1955.
