

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE SALE OF MALT, VINOUS AND SPIRITUOUS LIQUORS AND LIMITING THE SALE OF MALT, VINOUS AND SPIRITUOUS LIQUORS TO SPECIFIED CLASS OF LICENSE, MAKING SALES IN VIOLATION OF LIMITATION UNLAWFUL AND AMENDING RELATED AND CONFLICTING ORDINANCES.

Be it ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Las Animas, Bent County, Colorado

Section 1. The following proposed Ordinance shall be submitted to the electors of the City of Las Animas, Bent County, Colorado, as hereinafter provided and, if approved by a majority of said electors voting at said election, shall be effective as hereinafter provided.

Section 2. That from and after the 4th day of January 1958, sale of Malt, Vinous or Spirotous liquors in the City of Las Animas, Colorado shall be limited to sales by licensees licensed under the provisions of Section 75-2-19, C. R. S., 1953, Retail Liquor Store License and by that statutory provision authorized.

Section 3. Article 4 of Chapter 4 of Ordinance No. 333 of the City of Las Animas, Bent County, Colorado, is hereby amended as follows:

Add new Sections 4, 5, and 6 to read as follows:

4-4-4. No persons, association, or corporation shall, within the City of Las Animas, (or within one-half mile of the outer boundaries of said city,) manufacture for sale of gift, sell or keep for sale any malt, vinous or spiritous liquors to another, or permit another to keep for sale any malt, vinous or spiritous liquors or sell any malt, vinous or spiritous liquors on any premises owned or controlled by him or it, except such sales as may be made by licensees licensed under the provisions of Section 75-2-19, C. R. S., 1953 and unless by such provision authorized.

4-4-5. It shall be unlawful for any person, association or corporation to solicit or take any Order or Orders for any purchase or purchases of malt, vinous or spiritous liquors in any manner whatsoever except as in Section 4-4-4 of this Ordinance provided.

4-4-6. It shall be unlawful for any person to carry on or about his person, or for any person, association or corporation to engage or employ any other person, association or corporation to engage or employ any other person to so carry, in any quantity, any malt, vinous, or spiritous liquors for the purpose of selling, bartering, exchanging, giving away or delivering the same within the City of Las Animas in violation of Section 4-4-4 of this Ordinance.

Section 4. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall be submitted to a vote of the qualified electors of the City of Las Animas, Bent County, Colorado, at the biennial regular election to be held November 5, 1957, for their approval or rejection, under the local option provisions of Section 75-2-30, C. R. S. 1953. Each elector voting at said election and desirous of voting for or against said Ordinance, shall deposit in the ballot box a ballot whereon shall be printed the foregoing proposed Ordinance and the words, "For the limitation of the sale of Malt, Vinous, or Spiritous liquors to sales made by Retail Liquor Stores licensed under Provisions of section 75-2-19, C. R. S., 1953, and the words, "Against the limitations of the Sale of Malt, Vinous or Spiritous liquors" and shall indicate his choice by putting a cross (X) opposite one or the other of said groups of words. The votes cast for the adoption or rejection of said Ordinance shall be canvassed and the result determined in the manner provided by the laws of the State of Colorado and the ordinances of the City of Las Animas, for the canvassing of votes for alderman.
