

ORDINANCE NO. 351

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE No. 339 RELATING TO BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE CITY LIBRARY PRESCRIBING ITS POWERS AND DUTIES.

Be it ordained by the City Counsel of The City of Las Animas, Bent County, Colorado:


Section 1. Section 2 of Ordinance No. 339 is amended to read:

"Section 2. Board of Trustees. The management and control of the library shall be vested in a board of five (5) trustees who shall be appointed by the Mayor with the consent of the City Council of the City of Las Animas. The first appointment of such board of trustees shall be for terms of one, two, three, four and five years, respectively, and thereafter a trustee shall be appointed annually to serve for five (5) years. Vacancies shall be filled for the unexpired terms as soon as possible in the manner in which the members of the board are regularly chosen. A library trustee may be removed only by vote of the City Council. The Mayor and City Clerk shall be ex-officio members of said Board of Trustees and entitled to attend all meetings. The mayor shall preside as ex-officio chairman and in case of a tie vote the Mayor as ex-officio member shall vote to break the tie. The City Clerk shall be ex-officio clerk of the Board of Trustees and all warrants drawn upon the "library fund" of the City Treasurer shall be signed by the Mayor and City Clerk. "


Section 2. WHEREAS, in the opinion of the City Council of the City of Las Animas an emergency exists and this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety; therefore this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon the expiration of ten (10) days from and after its final passage and publication.
