ORDINANCE NO. 360

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING TAXES FOR THE YEAR 1966, TO DEFRAY THE COST OF MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT OF THE CITY OF LAS ANIMAS, BENT COUNTY, COLORADO, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 1966 and ENDING DECEMBER 31, 1966.

WHEREAS, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS ANIMAS, has adopted a budger for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 1966 and ending December 31, 1966, and whereas, the City Council has determined that the proper mill levy upon each dollar of the assessed valuation of all taxable property wit the City of Las Animas is 12 mills. Now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS ANIMAS COLORADO:

Section 1: That for the purpose of defraying expenses of the general fund of the City of Las Animas, Colorado, during the fiscal year beginning on January 1, 1966 and ending December 31 1966, ther is hereby levied a tax of 12 mills upon each dollar of the total assessed valuation of all taxable property within the City of Las Animas for the year 1966.

Section 2: That for the purpose of defraying the expenses of operating and maintaining a public library during the fiscal year beginning January 1, 1966 and ending December 31, 1966, there is hereby levied a tax of 1.5 mills upon each dollar of the total assessed valuation of all taxable property within the City of Las Animas for the year 1966.

Section 3: That the Ci y Clerk is hereby authorized and di-rected to immediately certify the County Commissioners of Bent County, Colorado, the total tax leby of the City of Las Animas, Colorado as herein set fourth, to be introduced, read, adopted on the first reading this 4th day of October, 1965.
