AN ORDINANCE FOR THE REGULATION OF TRAFFIC UPON THE PUBLIC STREETS OF THE CITY OF LAS ANIMAS, COLORADO, "MODEL TRAFFIC CODE FOR COLORADO MUNICIPALITY, COLORADO 1966", AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS ANIMAS, BENT COUNTY, COLORADO:

Section 1: Pursuant to Chapter 139, Article 34, CRS 1963. There is hereby adopted for the purpose of regulating traffic within the City of Las Animas, Bent County, Colorado, that certain ordinance known as "The Model Traffic Code for Colorado's Municipality, 1966" officially approved adopted and published as such by the Colorado Highway Safety Council and hereinafter referred to as the "Municipal Traffic Code" of which three (3) copies are now filed in the Office of the City Clerk and may be inspected during regular business hours, the same being adopted as if set out at length, save and except the following Articles and Sections declared to be inapplicable to this Municipality and are hereby expressly deleted, to-wit:

Section 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.-----Section 27-6 of said Model Traffic Code for Colorado Municipality as amended to read: Section 27-6.----- This Ordinance shall take effect from and after the 18th day of July, A.D. 1966, passed and adopted by the City Council this 5th day of July, 1966.
