

AN ORDINANCE amending the AMENDMENT of Ordinance 1V
page 39, Book of Ordinances, TOWN OF NUCLA, Colorado.

BE IT ^{repealed}ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the Town Of Nucla,
That section XVI of Ordinance No. IV be amended to read as follows:
All water rates shall be due and payable monthly in advance
during the first ten days of each month in each year without
notice or demand, provided, however, that it shall be the duty of
the Town Clerk and Recorder to send by mail on the first of each
month a written or printed notice to the agent or owner of all
premises where water is used notifying such owner or agent that
the water rent for such premises is due, and unless paid within
the time herein specified, the said water will be turned off;
but in all cases the property will be held for the water rate.

Repealed

The following resolution in regard to the water rates was drawn up by the Board of Trustees at a meeting held July 12, 1933.

Whereas: It is expedient that the water rules, rates and regulations be changed to comply with the new water ordinance, and,

Whereas: Existing conditions make it advisable to change the water rates in some instances, therefore,

Resolved by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Nucla, Colorado, the rates rules and regulations for the Nucla Water Works Department be made to read as follows;

Section 1. All places strictly residential shall be subject to the following rates;

Residence, without toilet or bath,	\$1.00 per mo.
Residence with bath (either tub or shower)	1.25
Residence with one toilet,	1.25
Residence, each additional toilet	.25
Residence with bath and toilet	1.50
Residence, carrying charge	.50

Any dwelling occupied regularly by more than one family shall pay for each separate family the same as a private residence.

Any dwelling where the occupant keeps more than one boarder or roomer shall be placed upon a meter.

Section 2. All establishments or places of business not strictly residential shall be placed upon a meter.

Any owner of a residence shall be allowed to be placed upon a meter.

Schedule of rates for metered service shall be per month as follows;

For the first 10,000 gallons	.25 per 1000 gallons
For the next 10,000 "	.20 " 1000 "
For the next 15,000 "	.15 " 1000 "
For the next 25,000 "	.12 1/2 " 1000 "
All over 60,000 "	.10 " 1000 "

The minimum charge for the metered service shall be \$1.00 per month.

Section 3. For irrigation purposes no person shall be allowed to use a meter except through one nozzle which shall not exceed 1/4 inch in diameter.

Rates for the irrigation season on lots;

For two lots- frontage,	\$5.00
For all additional area at the rate of \$2.50 per lot or equivalent area.	

Section 4. For filling cisterns the rate shall be as follows;

75 barrel or less	\$3.00
over 75 bbl. to 150 bbl.	4.00
over 150 bbl.	5.00

31.5 gal bbls.

The foregoing resolution signed by the Mayor and Clerk was ordered posted with the copies of the new Ordinance No. 11 on July 13, 1933.

The resolution was adopted on a motion by Fred Sly seconded by Mrs. Ray.
