

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO SALARY OF CERTAIN ELECTED OFFICIALS, APPOINTED OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF LAS ANIMAS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS ANIMAS, COLORADO:

Section 1. Elected Officials.

A. The following elected city officials shall receive annual salaries payable monthly as follows:

B. The City Clerk and Treasurer shall receive an annual salary payable monthly. The amount of said salary shall be \$5,940.00 at the time this Ordinance is passed but may be increased from time to time as the City Council shall prescribe by resolution.

Section 2. Appointed Officials.

A. The Municipal Judge shall receive an annual salary of \$2,400.00, payable monthly.

B. The City Attorney shall receive as payment for his services the amount of \$15.00 per hour of time spent in the service of the City of Las Animas, payable monthly as presented by voucher to the City Clerk and Treasurer.

Section 3. All employees of the City of Las Animas shall receive such salaries as shall be established by the City of Las Animas general policy.

Section 4. The City Clerk and Treasurer upon taking official notice of the existing incumbency of the city offices set forth in Sections 1 and 2, shall issue vouchers and draw warrants for the monthly compensation if provided in said Sections 1 and 2.

Section 5. The compensation provided for in this Ordinance shall be payable to those persons elected or appointed to the offices specified in Sections 1 and 2 and those employees in the employment of the City of Las Animas in the calendar year 1974 and thereafter, and to those officials appointed to fill vacancies in those offices referred to in Sections 1 and 2 arising through death, resignation or otherwise, and to any subsequent employees of the City of Las Animas.

Section 6. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 7. The City Council finds, determines and declares that this action is necessary for the protection of the public peace, health and safety
