AN ORDINANCE VACATING COTTONWOOD AVENUE FROM EIGHTH STREET TO THE SANTA FE RAILROAD TRACKS.

WHEREAS, the School Board of School District Re. 1 has petitioned the City Council of the City of Las Animas, for permission to use the street area of Cottonwood Avenue from its intersection with Eighth Street to the dead end of Cottonwood Avenue at the Santa Fe Railroad Tracks, for a football practice field; and

WHEREAS, such section of Cottonwood Avenue is not regularly used by automobile traffic, is not required for the normal flow of city traffic, and has not been regularly maintained by the city for a number of years; and

WHEREAS, the School Board of School District Re. 1 has indicated a desire to use the property as part of a football practice field, and the City Council of the City of Las Animas desires to further the athletic endeavors of the School Board.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS ANIMAS, COLORADO: that section of Cottonwood Avenue terminated by Eighth Street on the North and the Santa Fe Railroad Tracks on the South is hereby vacated.
