

ORDINANCE NO. 471

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE DRINKING AND POSSESSION OF MALT, VINOUS AND SPIRITUOUS LIQUORS AND FERMENTED MALT BEVERAGES WITHIN THE CITY OF LAS ANIMAS, COLORADO.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS ANIMAS, COLORADO:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful to drink or be in possession of an open container of malt, vinous or spirituous liquors or fermented malt beverages in the City of Las Animas upon any public street, alley or public way; *upon any* or upon any parking lot or drive-in area, ~~including all school property,~~ which is either publicly or privately owned and used by the public.


Section 2. The fact that a person is in or upon a motor vehicle at the time of such drinking or possession is not a defense in any prosecution under this Ordinance.

Section 3. Any person convicted of violating this Ordinance shall be fined in an amount not to exceed \$300.00 or be confined in the City jail for a time to not exceed ninety (90) days or by both such fine and imprisonment.



The City Council of the City of Las Animas hereby finds, determines and declares that an emergency exists and that this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety and the same shall be in full force and effect after publication and final passage as provided by law.
