

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING A PORTION OF SECTION 26-5 OF THE MODEL TRAFFIC CODE FOR COLORADO MUNICIPALITIES, 1977 REVISION, AND CHANGING BENT AVENUE BETWEEN SEVENTH STREET AND EIGHTY STREET FROM ONE-WAY TRAFFIC FLOW TO TWO-WAY TRAFFIC FLOW.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Las Animas, Colorado, has determined, that because of recent street modifications, motor vehicle traffic flow from Seventh Street to Eighty Street on Bent Avenue in the City of Las Animas, Colorado, will be more efficient and convenient for motorists if traffic flow is made two-way, and

WHEREAS, Section 26-5 of the 1977 revision of the Model Traffic Code for Colorado Municipalities as adopted by reference by the City of Las Animas, Colorado, now requires that traffic flow be one-way from south to north.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS ANIMAS, COLORADO,

1. That the portion of Section 26-5 of the Model Traffic Code for Colorado Municipalities as adopted by reference by the City of Las Animas, Colorado, (line 2 of Schedule V) is hereby repealed.

2. That traffic on Bent Avenue between Seventh Street and Eighth Street shall now flow in two directions.
