

ORDINANCE NO. 543

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A VETERANS MEMORIAL IN THE CITY OF LAS ANIMAS, COLORADO, AND SETTING FORTH THE RULES FOR THE USE THEREOF:

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Las Animas, Colorado, recognizes the patriotism, sacrifices and contributions of its citizens who have served in this nations armed services; and

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to pay tribute to its citizens who have served in the nations armed services by establishing a memorial in honor of all veterans; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to provide an appropriately dignified atmosphere and location for such veterans memorial.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS ANIMAS, COLORADO, that:

I. That there is hereby established an area to be known as Veterans Memorial.

II. The location of Veterans' Memorial shall be upon the following described real property located in Bent County, Colorado:

All of Lot 6 in BURCHETT'S SUBDIVISION in the N.E.¼ of Section 9, Township 23 South, Range 52 West of the Sixth Principal Meridian, and a tract or parcel located in BURCHETT'S SUBDIVISION, in the N.E.¼ of Section 9, Township 23 South, Range 52, West of the Sixth Principal Meridian, said tract or parcel beginning at a point which is located at the Northwest corner of Lot 6, BURCHETT'S SUBDIVISION, thence in an Easterly direction along the North line of said Lot 6 a distance of 110 feet; thence Northerly along a line connecting the N.E. corner of Lot 6 and the S.E. corner of Lot 5, a distance of 16 feet to the centerline of vacated 7th Street; thence Westerly along the centerline of vacated 7th Street, a distance of 100 feet to a point on a line connecting the S.W. corner of Lot 5 to the N.W. corner of Lot 6; thence Southerly along said line which connects the S.W. corner of Lot 5 to the N.W. corner of Lot 6, a distance of 16 feet, to the point of beginning.

AND

A tract or parcel of land in Lots 7 and 8, BURCHETT'S SUBDIVISION, in the N.E.¼ of Section 9, Township 23 South, Range 52, West of the Sixth Principal Meridian, said tract or parcel being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the West line of Lot 8, of BURCHETT'S SUBDIVISION as shown on the plat filed the 20th day of April, 1964 with the Bent County Colorado Clerk and Recorder, from which the E.¼ corner (found 3½" aluminum cap) of Section 9, T. 23 S., R. 52 W., of the 6th P.M. bears S. 69° 05' 39" E., a distance of 1,301.23 feet.

1. Thence along the West line of said Lot 8, N. 0° 17' 28" E. a distance of 86.21 feet, more or less to a point of beginning;
2. Thence N. 69° 56' 53" E., a distance of 89.51 feet;
3. Thence N. 56° 15' 01" E., a distance of 31.47 feet to the East line of said Lot 7;
4. Thence along the East line N. 0° 17' 28" E. to the N.E. corner of said Lot 7;
5. Thence West along the North line of Lot 7 to the NW corner of said Lot 7;
6. Thence along said West line S. 0° 17' 28" West to the point of beginning.

AND

A parcel of land described as follows: That part of Lots 11, 12, 13 and 14 of the Bent County Bank Subdivision, Las Animas, Colorado, of the E½SE½ of Section 4 and E½NE½ of Section 9, Township 23 South, Range 52, West of the 6th P.M., lying and being within the following metes and bounds: For a point of beginning, 1334 feet South the Northeast corner of Section 9, Township 23 South, Range 52, West of the 6th P.M., thence West 855 feet, thence South 411 feet to the point of beginning, thence West 315 feet, thence South to the North boundary of right-of-way of U.S. Highway 50, thence East Northeast along the North right-of-way boundary of said U.S. Highway 50 to a point on said boundary directly South of the Point of beginning, thence North to the point of beginning.

III. It shall be unlawful to use Veterans Memorial for any of the following described purposes:

1. Any kind of game or contest.
2. Picnicking or consumption of food or beverages.
3. Use or parking of vehicles on the premises.
4. Use of any athletic equipment or children's toys or play equipment or use of the premises as a playground.
5. Any use from sundown to sunup.
6. Planting or growing of any shade trees.

IV. Section 14-38 of the Las Animas City Code shall apply to the area at all times.
