

ORDINANCE NO. 546

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING SECTION 14-45 OF THE LAS ANIMAS CITY CODE REGARDING VAGRANCY AND ENACTING A TRESPASS ORDINANCE.

WHEREAS, the VAGRANCY ordinance, Section 14-45 of the Las Animas City Code, has become obsolete, is probably unconstitutional, and unenforceable; and

WHEREAS, the Las Animas City Council has determined that it is in the best interests of the citizens of the City of Las Animas to repeal Section 14-45 of the Las Animas City Code; and

WHEREAS, the Las Animas City Council also has determined that Section 14-45 of the Las Animas City Code should be replaced with an enforceable trespass ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS ANIMAS, COLORADO, that:

1. Section 14-45 of the Las Animas City Code is hereby repealed and re-enacted as the Criminal Trespass ordinance as follows:

2. Criminal Trespass. A person commits the crime of criminal trespass if he unlawfully enters or remains in or upon premises.


