

Ordinance No. 625

AN ORDINANCE CLARIFYING MATTERS AS TO
THE CITY TRAFFIC ENGINEER

WHEREAS, the City of Las Animas has adopted a Model Traffic Code as is set forth in Section 13-1 of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Animas; and

WHEREAS, in addition thereto, the City has adopted Article II entitled "Parking Restrictions" as enumerated in Section 13-2 through Section 13-9 inclusive; and

WHEREAS, the City has adopted an "Emergency Truck Route" as enumerated in Section 13-10 through Section 13-11 inclusive of the Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, the City is desirous of standardizing certain provisions contained therein;

BE IT THEREFORE AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

- a. Section 13-10(d)(1) is repealed in its entirety.
- b. A new Section 13-10(d)(1) is enacted as follows:
 - (d) Enforcement.
 - (1) Maintenance of Signs. The Department of Public Works shall cause streets upon which heavy vehicles are prohibited to be clearly sign-posted, in accordance with the Model Traffic Code, to give notice that this section is in effect.
 - (A) Failure to Post. No person shall be charged with violating the provisions of the ordinance codified in this section by reason of operating or parking a heavy vehicle upon a street wherein heavy vehicle travel or parking is prohibited unless appropriate signs are posted on such street.
- c. A new Section 13-20 is enacted as follows:

13-20. The Director of Public Works is designated as the City's Traffic Engineer for all matters requiring the designation of a City Traffic Engineer.


